

## **2. Data Analysis Procedures**

IHCC and DCTC are highly committed to gathering the best evaluation data available for formative and summative purposes. The comprehensive evaluation plan by activity objective is shown in Table 27. The plan is designed to produce a valid assessment of the implementation strategies and result in quantifiable evidence of the extent to which goals and objectives have been attained. Data sources to be used for this project are included in Table 27. Evaluation of implementation strategies will be conducted through a comprehensive process. Each item in a strategy will be assigned a quantitative value of 1-5, where the number "1" means the item was not carried out according to the original strategy, and "5" means that the item was conducted as originally planned. If there are deviations from the strategy, or if the item was carried out in another way, it will be explained in the comments line of a form. Responses on this form will provide additional quantitative evaluation of the implementation strategies and serve to strengthen the management of the project by helping IHCC and DCTC understand what works in achieving the desired outcomes and impacts.
